





15 LO in Kraków - there are around 400 students in all the three

years and less than 40 teachers. Students may choose the major subjects they are interested in, so they can specialize in humanities (History, Literature, Social Sciences, foreign languages) or sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Maths, Geography). There is also a wide range of extra-curricular classes and optional courses students can choose from - art classes, theatre, sport clubs, media and photo clubs, etc. Students write articles for our school magazine, make films and cooperate with local communities.

15 LO Kraków - located in the suburbs, in a big urban area, attracts

teenagers from the nearby villages and small towns such as Wieliczka, Niepołomice, Gaj, Skawina. We are known as a school that creates safe and friendly environment and caters for the needs of both the talented and those who require special attention (at present 10 students are following an individual development plan). We have students with special needs: disabled, socalled "euro-orphans' with educational problems, some at risk of social exclusion, many students get regular financial help, i.e. scholarship from the charity organisation called "Caritas" due to parents' unemployment.
